The General Assembly,

- 1) Requests the demilitarization of the Ukrainian-Russian border with the aims of:
 - a) stopping the armed conflict between Russian and Ukrainian forces,
 - b) freeing the Ukrainian territories from Russian occupation,
 - i) during the retreat of the Russian army, the Ukrainian soldiers must not shoot to enemies or impede their return home,
 - ii) during the retreat, the Russian army must not destroy anything or kill or capture anyone,
 - c) preserving peace in the future,
 - d) rebuilding cities and infrastructures,
 - e) helping civilians to move back to their homes;
- 2) Urges the removal of the EU economic sanctions against the Russian Federation in order to:
 - a) revive the Russian economy, so as in turn the Russian Federation will economically support Ukraine in the reconstruction process of houses, factories, infrastructures,
 - b) stop the economic tensions between EU and Russia,
 - c) help both the EU and Russia to recover from the economic crisis due to COVID-19 pandemic;
- 3) Establishes that Crimea becomes part of the Russian Federation with the approval of the UN;
- 4) Strongly affirms that Ukraine cannot enter the NATO without the Russian permission.

The General Assembly,

- 1) Declares the neutrality of Ukraine to these conditions:
 - a) the withdrawal of Russian troops,
 - b) the role of guarantor played by China;
- 2) Affirms the governmental authority of Russia on the Ukrainian territory of Crimea;
- 3) Holds a referendum in The Republics of Donbass in order to allow the population to decide whether to be ruled by the Russian or Ukrainian government;
- 4) Establishes a city exchange between Russia and Ukraine, consisting in the restitution of an harbour city to Ukraine for each inland city given to Russia;
- 5) Urges Russia to provide economic support to Ukraine in order to rebuild the destroyed cities;
- 6) Strongly encourages Russia to welcome Ukrainian refugees and allow them to decide about their return to Ukraine;
- 7) Proclaims the hegemony of Ukraine and the ban imposed on Russia to export grain to EU member countries.
